Dear Scholarship Applicant:

Although you have already submitted an application through Scholar Dollars, we are asking that you provide the Department of Theatre Arts with additional information and materials needed for our departmental scholarships. Please send this supplementary application material by email to the department's administrative assistant, Susie Ouderkirk (susieo@nmsu.edu) instead of in a report folder with hard copies as we have done in the past.

The department's Scholarship Committee encourages you to submit these supplementary documents in a way that is thoughtful, clear, detailed, and professionally presented. This is a very competitive process and not everyone who applies will receive a scholarship; therefore, please take the time and care to make sure that your materials are as polished as possible. We will consider your presentation among other criteria in determining awards.

For your supplementary application packet, you are asked to send the following materials by email as follows:

1. A cover letter that introduces you to the Scholarship Committee

Information to include: your name, your current year in school, how long you have been a Theatre Arts major, any additional majors or minors, your area of theatrical emphasis (if you have one), a brief overview of your theatrical career since starting as a student at NMSU, and any other information you feel is pertinent for the committee members to know about you as they make their decisions. Please date and sign your letter (a scanned document is fine for the purpose of sending by email).

2. A supplementary scholarship form.

Typed, completely filled out, and including a notation of the scholarships that are listed and for which you would like to be considered.

3. A scholarship questionnaire.

Typed, on the form itself or on separate sheets of paper. Please be thorough in your responses. The more care that you take with your answers, the more serious consideration the committee can give to your application.

4. Your current theatre resume

See sample following.

5. A current headshot

Color, 8 1/2" x 11. We will use this headshot in lobby displays, announcements, etc. should you be selected as a scholarship recipient, so please be sure it is professional and appropriate for public display (see examples here).

To qualify for a Theatre Arts scholarship, during the time of your award you must be a full time student, a declared major in Theatre Arts, and have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0.

All of these supplementary application materials must be sent to the Department of Theatre Arts office no later than 4 pm on Monday, April 2, 2018.

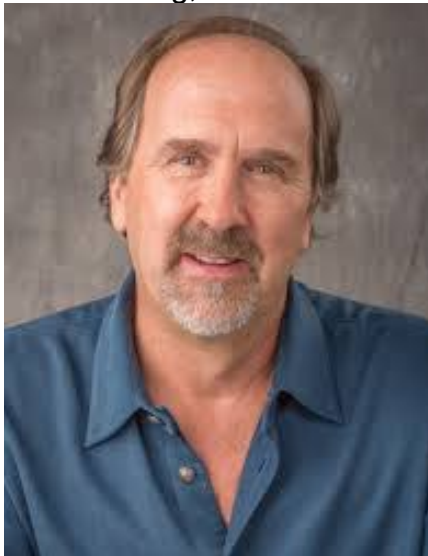


HEADSHOT

Because of this, we will use your headshots in our lobby display, etc. Please ensure your headshot is clear, highlights your personality and looks like you currently look. It must be full color and printed on 8 ½ x 11" paper or photo paper.

GOOD EXAMPLES (not to size)

Face is centered, background non-distracting, clear



BAD EXAMPLES

Face not centered in frame, too much background, obvious screen capture
Bad angle, not posed, dressed poorly, other people in photo
Black and white, badly Photoshopped.
